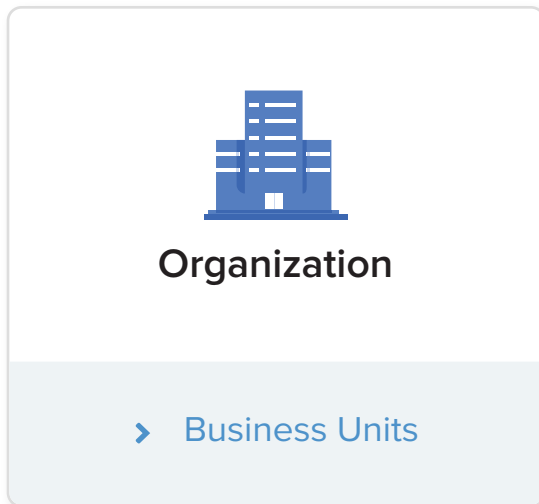

How does it work?

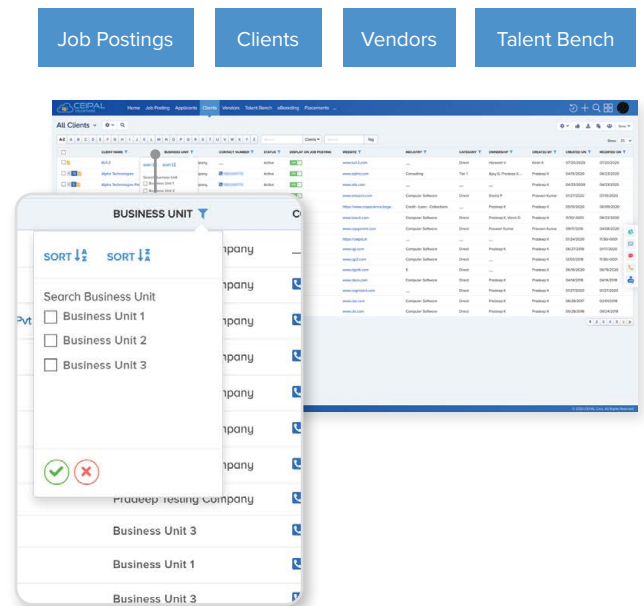
- 1 Create as many **Business Units** as you need
